People who have a severe allergy to chicken eggs, have had a severe reaction to flu shots or have a moderate or severe illness with a fever










Downed utility lines, power company blackouts, heavy snow falls or summer storms can all lead to power outages. Many people turn to a portable generator for a temporary solution without knowing the risks.

- 3)) Generators should be used in well ventilated locations outside away from all doors, windows and vent openings.
- Never use a generator in an attached garage, even with the door open.
- Place generators so that exhaust fumes can't enter the home through windows, doors or other openings in the building.
- Make sure to install carbon monoxide (CO) alarms in your home. Follow manufacturer's instructions for correct placement and mounting height.
- Turn off generators and let them cool down before refueling. Never refuel a generator while it is bot

Just Remember..

When plugging in appliances, make sure they are plugged directly into the generator or a heavy duty outdoor-rated extension cord. The cords should be checked for cuts, tears and that the plug has all three prongs, especially a grounding pin.

If you must connect the generator to the house wiring to power appliances, have a qualified electrician install a properly rated transfer switch in accordance with the National Electrical Code® (NEC) and all applicable state and local electrical codes.

FACT



WHAT IS THE PROGRAM?

Mobile Crisis program is funded by a three-year, \$750,000 federal Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) grant



The grant is part of the BJA's Justice and Mental Health Collaboration Program



It is a joint project of the City of Roseburg and Compass Behavioral Health

Mobile Crisis is intended as an intervention to divert individuals with mental illness away from the Jail and the Emergency Department and into services when appropriate



THE PROBLEM

- Nationwide, people with serious mental illness are booked into local Jails about 2 million times each year (many also cycle through the Emergency Room).
- Three-quarters of these individuals also have drug/alcohol use problems.
- These individuals tend to stay longer in Jail than those without mental illness, and are at higher risk of returning to Jail upon release.
- Jails spend 2-3 times more money on adults with mental illness than those without.
- Thirty-six percent of people booked into the Douglas County Jail during a onemonth period in 2018 were flagged as possibly having a mental illness.

Mobile Crisis Team

THE PROBLEM (CONT.)

- Douglas County 2018 population 110,000 +/-
 - Compass identified 8300 residents with a mental health diagnosis. *This did not include those with other service providers or the uninsured.*
 - Douglas County has 1 mental health provider for every 390 people, versus an average of 1 for every 230 people statewide.
- 160 provider shortfall





Medical Education College – George Fox University

Addressing a Need in Southern Oregon

The need for healthcare education in Southern Oregon is great, as the region faces "growing allied and mental health workforce shortages that pose serious healthcare access issues," according to Kelly Morgan, CEO of Mercy Medical Center in Roseburg, Oregon, and a longtime member of the Oregonians for Rural Health coalition.

George Fox has expanded its healthcare education offerings in recent years, adding a <u>Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree</u> (2004), a doctorate in <u>physical therapy</u> (2012) and an <u>RN to BSN degree-completion program</u> (2019). The university will also begin a <u>physician assistant program</u> in January of 2021.




