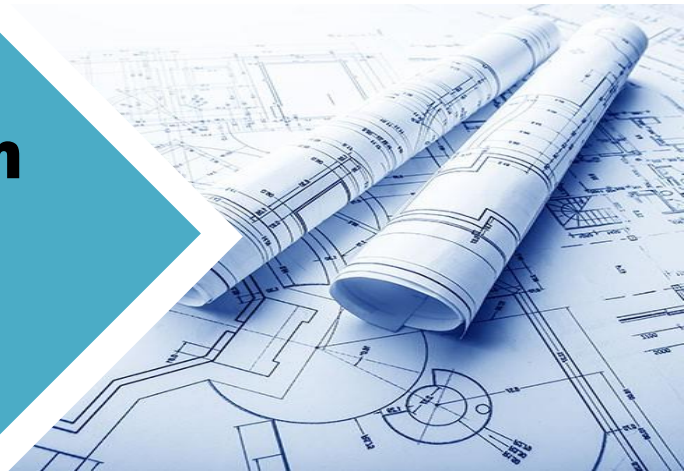

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the City of Roseburg is accepting applications from individuals interested to serve on the following Commission to the City Council:

Planning Commission: Meets at 7:00 p.m. on the first Monday of each month to consider long and short range land use development issues within the City and Urban Growth Boundary. The City of Roseburg Planning Commission consists of seven citizens appointed by the City Council. The Planning Commission reviews and takes action on land use and development projects based on the provisions of the City of Roseburg Land Use and Development Regulations (LUDR). The Commission reviews and acts on Quasi-Judicial applications (those filed by land owners and/or their agents) and on Legislative applications (those initiated by the City). While some actions are a recommendation forwarded to the City Council for final consideration, other decisions are final unless appealed to the City Council.

At least six of the members must be residents of the City; the other member may reside outside City limits, but must reside within the Urban Growth Boundary of the City. This current vacancy requires residency within the City. Except when filling a vacant unexpired term, all Commissioners are appointed for a four-year term.

This position will remain open until Monday, December 6, 2021 by 5:00 p.m. Planning Commission interviews are tentatively scheduled prior to the 7:00 p.m. City Council Meeting on December 13, 2021. Qualified applicants will be notified to schedule a time for an interview.
