EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Roseburg Public Library performed well in terms of circulation, programming, and library usage. The library consistently outperformed the state average in these areas despite having fewer employees compared with other similar-sized libraries. The library provided a wide range of programs and services to the community, attracting a growing number of visitors and readers.

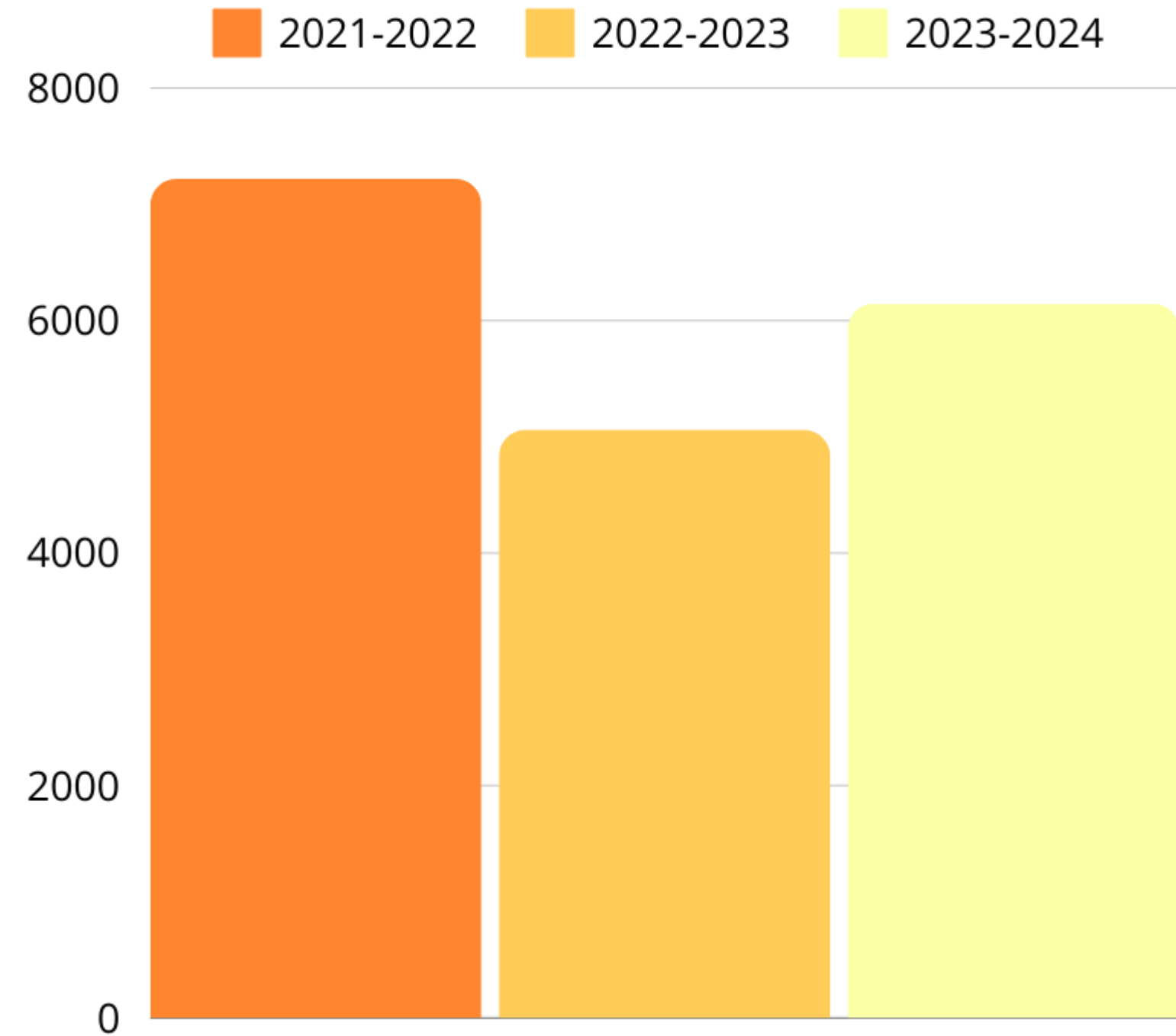

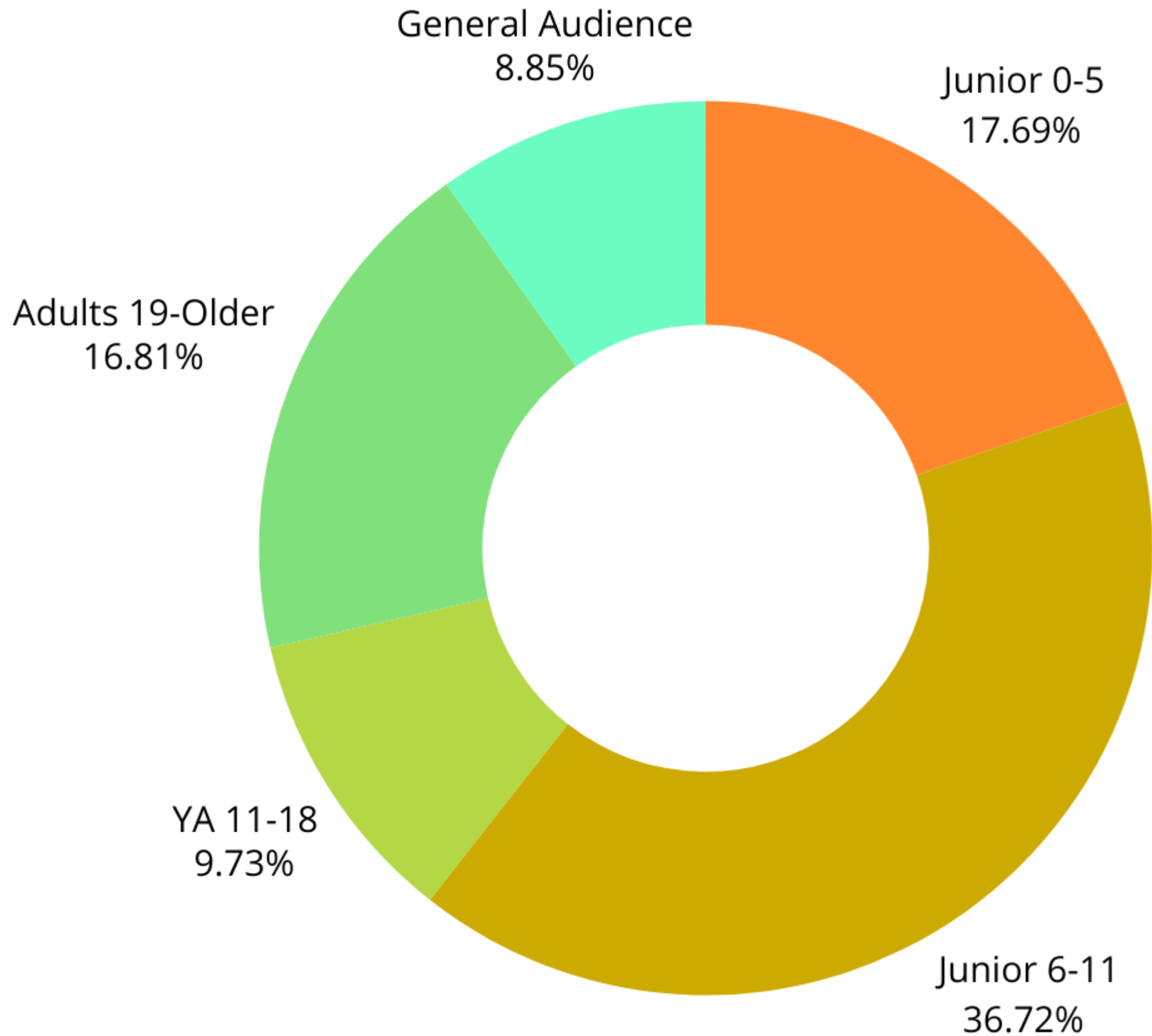

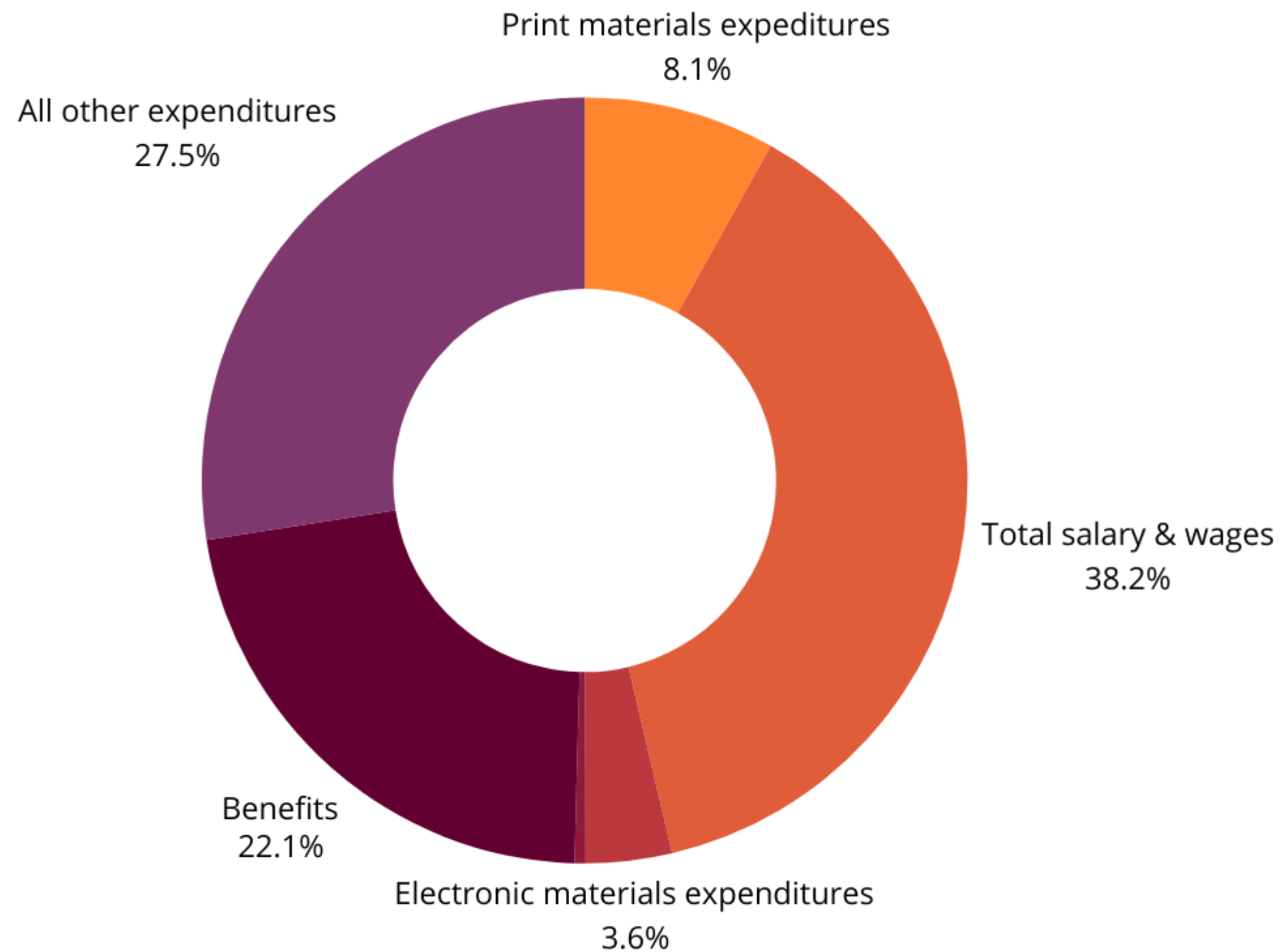
Contributed a total of 1,289 hours. Similar-sized libraries had 22.61 volunteers contributing 944 hours.

VOLUNTEERED HOURS

85.9

Each volunteer committed to an average of 85.9 hours in 2022-2023. That was 7.2 hours a month. Similar-sized libraries' volunteers each contributed an average of 41.75 hours, or 3.5 hours a month.

Expenditures

Expenditures totaled \$632,518

The average annual expenditures for libraries with populations 17,000 - 27,000 was \$1,012,471.

State average

- Total salary and wages was 45.92% of total expenditures on average.
- Benefits were 18.89% on average
- Print materials expenditures were 6.49% on average
- Electronic material expenditures was 1.88% on average
- All other expenditures was 23.96% on average
