3. Write book reviews for a chance to win one of four \$50 gift cards to these businesses located in Roseburg.

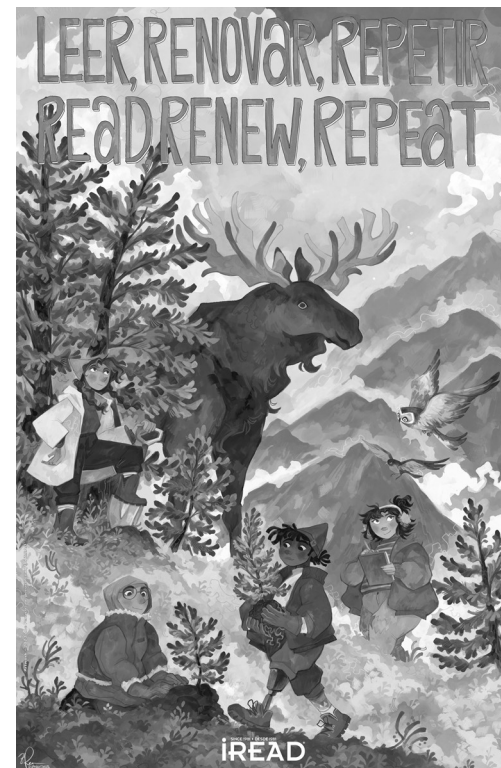
